REMINDER: Transportation Fees 2026-2027 To secure your child/ren place with our Transportation Department a deposit of LE 5,000 needs to be paid to secure your spot. If payment is made after that date, confirmation of providing the service will be based on availability. The remaining balance will be settled in August.
